WHERE DO I BEGIN TO LOOK?

✓ **Network with other grant writers**

- Many times other grant writers will have experience with various funding sources, and they are usually glad to share this information.

✓ **Make an appointment to visit your city and county economic development agencies**

- These entities will have information about public monies available (contracts or grants) for your project.

✓ **Look on your various state agency's websites**

- Each state agency will usually have a section specifying grant opportunities and resources.



✓ **Call your congressional team members**

- **Let them know about your organization and its need for grant funding. Ask if they can start to track any federal bucks that fit your needs.**

✓ **Grants.gov**

- **Managed by the Department of Health and Human Services, Grants.gov is an E-Government initiative operating under the governance of the Office of Management and Budget. Under the President's Management Agenda, the office was chartered to deliver a system that provides a centralized location for grant seekers to find and apply for federal funding opportunities.**
