Signing, Pavement Markings and MUTCD: Covers what is required to comply with Part VI of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), Temporary Traffic Control, familiarizing students with theory of how traffic control devices and signs are properly used in temporary traffic control situations, including flagging situations. Development of Traffic Control Plans is also covered.



Asphalt Pavement Maintenance Practices: Increases participants' awareness of the various pavement maintenance alternatives available and highlights the benefits of performing preventive maintenance on roadways to extend their service life, improve drivability and reduce



Plan Reading for Roadway Maintenance: Course covers the basic mathematical calculations required to understand how to properly plan, build and maintain roads. Participants will learn how to read building and construction plans.



Work Zone Traffic Control: Attendees will learn key elements required for temporary traffic control, safety, and flagging. Participants will learn roles, responsibilities and potential liabilities, learning to use best practices on ways to design and maintain highway work zones that improve safety for workers and drivers.



Bridge Inspection, Maintenance & Repair: Course is intended for road supervisors, maintenance engineers and maintenance-level personnel who have responsibility for inspection, maintenance and repair of bridges. Participants will become familiar with best practices for bridge maintenance and preservation, know what to do when repairs are needed and how to safely work on and around bridges.



Trailer Transport & Load Securement: Designed specifically for DOT, municipal public works, streets/roads departments, or any other agency employees who load, haul and unload heavy mobile equipment and other objects onto trucks and/or trailers.



Rights-of-Way Mowing & Maintenance Safety: For streets, roads, parks maintenance and/or transportation department employees, foremen or supervisors who maintain federal and state roadways, city/county or special district rights-of-way, infrastructure and other outdoor



Chainsaw (Tree Work) Safety: For agency employees who engage in tree work and are exposed to common tree work hazards and the risks associated with tree work machines and tools.



Hurricane/Storm Preparation & Recovery Operations: Discusses department level preparedness and reviews list of activities performed on a calendar basis and on a timeline basis once an emergency is declared. Activities include items that are critical as storms approach, pass over and exit the community. Many additional activities are detailed related to initiating and completing recovery process.



Excavating & Trench Safety (Comp. Person): Course identifies and addresses common excavating hazards and details protective measures and safe work practices for all phases of the excavating job.



Guardrail Installation, Maintenance and Repair: Features necessary to provide the best likelihood for good performance for metal guardrail standard systems and their end treatments, as well as length of need (including a field expedient procedure) and guardrail transitions, will be discussed.



Sign Maintenance & Management: The principles of this class will cover types of signs, materials, supports and installation. The instructor will teach how to develop a sign management system that will include maintenance, repair and replacement. The workshop will combine lectures, group discussion and practical exercises to enhance training.



Confined Space Entry: Course identifies and addresses common DOT-district permit required confined space situations rarely covered by other programs, and details safe work practices for most types of municipal confined space entry situations.







Heavy Equipment: Classroom and hands-on training for aerial lift, backhoe, broom truck, bucket truck, dozer, dump truck, forklift, front end loader, Gradall, scissor lift, skid steer, vac truck, Versahandler...and more!
