



INTERMEDIATE MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC - Refresher

An 8-hour FDOT Certification Course

Target Audience: This course is for those who are already IMOT certified* as specified by the Florida Department of Transportation. The IMOT-Refresher course is required every four years in order for all IMOT-certified persons to continue to be qualified to perform their assigned duties. Persons who have maintained current certification from an approved provider may take a training or refresher course to comply with this procedure.

The IMOT-Refresher course provides an overview of the Florida IMOT course with concentration given to the applicable changes that have occurred in the most recent four years to the Design Standards, Part 6 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), Plans Preparation Manual, Construction Project Administration Manual, and Standard Specifications for Road & Bridge Construction.

* *NOTE: IMOT initial certification is a separate 16-hour course for DOT District employees, municipal public works, streets/roads, parks, water utility and/or other city or county employees who are responsible for supervising and/or inspecting the installation, removal, and field maintenance of temporary traffic control (TTC) devices, (excluding temporary barriers, end treatments and crash cushions).*

This course utilizes DOT-provided course materials, and each participant receives a DOT-certified wallet card (with passing grade on DOT's final exam).
