JHA (Job Hazard Analysis) Training

Purpose of this Training Program: To train managers, supervisors, human resource and risk management personnel on how to perform a proper Job Hazard Analysis (JHA).

A JHA is an analysis of the hazards and risks associated with the performance of certain jobs at a workplace. Our JHA training program focuses on learning how to identify the specific hazards associated with each job or work activity and what is the best way to control or minimize those potential hazards.

The process we teach will help key personnel to identify existing and potential job hazards and assess the risk and identify methods to eliminate or protect against those hazards.

Utilizing the JHA procedures we teach and the forms we provide will help attendees develop the skills needed for analyzing hazardous work activities and identifying the tools, materials and equipment needed to develop work methods and procedures for accomplishing the task of creating a safer workplace.
