

Roadway Safety Fundamentals (I and II)

Course Overview: This course is designed to help participants understand the critical relationships between roads, roadsides, road user behavior and safety. Training is focused on conveying concepts, strategies, and practices that reduce fatalities and injuries on the road.

The one-day course (Fundamentals I) provides training on the following topics:

- Basics of road safety
- Identifying/solving traffic safety problems
- Human behavior factors involved in roadway
- safetyTraffic control devices

- ng on the following topics:Roadways design standards
- Curves and surface condition
- Improving roadside safety
- Intersections, railroad grade crossings and driveways

The two-day course (Fundamentals II) provides training on the following topics:

- Bridge safety
- Night work hazards and safety
- Importance of safety data and types of safety data available

Upon completion of this course, participants should:

- Have a clear understanding of the best practices used in communities to reduce roadway fatalities and injuries
- Understand the most important concepts involved in designing and maintaining safe roadways
- Have a firm understanding of the additional challenges of providing bridge safety
- Understand how to mitigate night work safety hazards for roadway workers
